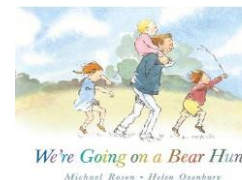

Communication, Language & Literacy

Listen to stories such as – The very Hungry caterpillar; Old MacDonald had a farm; We're going on a bear hunt;

Join in with repeated refrains from popular stories
Become aware of rhyme and alliteration
Ask questions to find out more
Ascribe meaning to their own marks
Phonics - revisit set 1 phonic sounds
Become confident in identifying initial sounds in words - play games such as I spy something beginning with...

Count objects to 10 and beyond
Compare two groups of objects and say when they have the same number
Recognise numerals in the environment
Match numerals to quantity
Represent numbers in different ways
Separate a group of three or four objects in different ways and realise the total is still the same
Show an awareness of similarities of shapes in the environment

Exploring Media and using Media

Make models of animals using recyclable materials
Paint or draw pictures of favourite animals
Explore animal print such as stripes, spots, patterns
Sing songs and rhymes
Make music - e.g. tapping on different equipment e.g. empty containers, tins, saucepans,
Move to music
