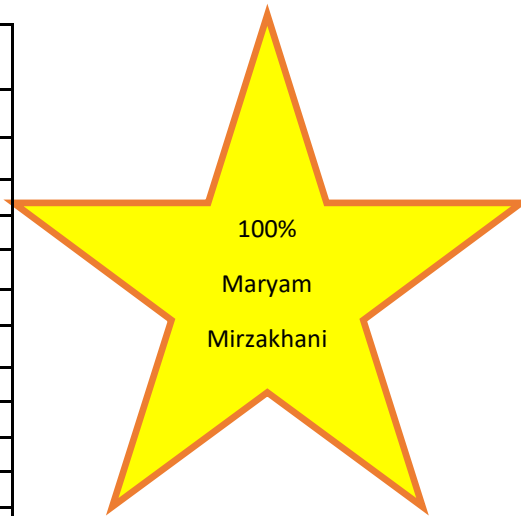


All children in Years Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are currently entitled to a free school meal each day. We encourage you to take this up.

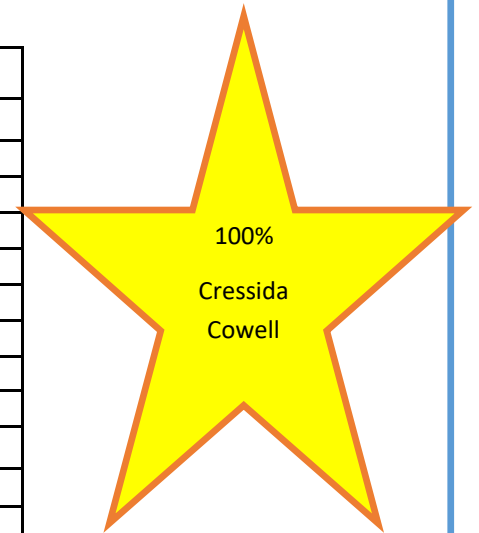
