

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hello everyone and huge congratulations to England for making it through to quarter finals of Euro Cup 20! Times Tables Rockstars Competition!

In July 2020, TTR organised the LONDON ROCKS competition and LFPA was in 17th position out of 418 schools! Our children achieved these amazing results due to our LFP values - Aiming High; their resilience and their teachers' encouragement. Now TTR has organised a similar competition so let's make sure that our children from Years 1 to 6 are all logging in and taking part in the competition this week which ends today at 7 pm. One final push tonight please (sorry Euro 2020)! We are currently 12th place but we need to better our last year's ranking and get into the top ten schools! The details are:

For every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, your child will earn their class a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours). Winning classes in the school and in the country as a whole will be the ones with the highest average. Let's aim to put LFPA on the map as the best school in TTR in London!

Finally on behalf of the governors, staff and myself, I would like to say a massive thank you to the teachers who are leaving us at the end of this term:

Mrs Patel—She has been the nursery manager for many years and is moving on to another school. Extension building works

We have building works going on in the KS1 playground to build an extension which would house four group rooms, so our pupils can make further progress in their learning.

Sorry for any inconvenience caused before and during this project. As soon as we receive communication about the building works, we aim to inform all parents via the website and school App.

I have just been informed that the original plan of closing the pathway from the car park to the school site for the SRP gate was planned for this week, but is now being extended to 12th July due to Niblock, the contractors are having issues with supply of building materials. So parents please continue to walk your children on the safe path from the car park to the main school entrance, located on Botwell Lane. The temporary office cabins for the workers will be installed on site on 8th July onwards.

I must assure you that all the risk assessments and DBS checks have been carried out in advance. The Park Federation's Estate Manager, Ms Ryder is overseeing the project. Please bring to our attention any issues, so we can make sure the building works continue in a safe and smooth manner and our children will have the extra learning space ready for Spring Term 2022.

The children, staff and I are all excited to see the extension building taking shape. I will give you regular updates on the newsletter together with pictures too.
