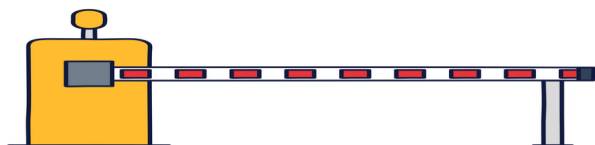


PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE
