Times Tables Rockstars Competition!

In July, TTR organised the LONDON ROCKS competition and LFPA was in 17th position out of 418 schools! Our children achieved these amazing results due to our LFP values - Aiming High; their resilience and their teachers' encouragement. We were up against secondary schools, private schools, 418 schools (in total) and our 9 classes out of 4104 classes in total! We did not have the advantage of year 6 children like the other schools - so these results show we are able to achieve amazing outcomes when we work together - pupils, teachers and parents. Now TTR has organised a similar competition so let's make sure that our children from Year 2 to 6 are all logging in and taking part in the competition next week! Please check the login details with the classteachers. The details are:

For every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, your child will earn their class a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours). Winning classes in the school and in the country as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

All game modes (Gig, Garage, Studio, etc.) will count but **only from games played between 7.30am and 7.30pm from Monday 9th till Saturday 14th November.**

Currently all the classes are neck to neck on the rankings but it's a battle of the giants between Marie Curie class and Zaha Hadid class!

We are currently 17th in the competition of schools. Let's aim to put LFPA on the map as the best school in TTR in London!
