Whole School Priorities 2019-2020

This year our targets are:

1. To improve the quality of provision in Nursery and Reception.
2. To raise Achievement in Reading, Writing and Maths.
3. To embed consistency of behaviour expectations following the LFP values and school ethos.

Through these core values our aim is to create a positive learning environment; self – discipline, co – operation and respect are key features we expect to see in all areas of our academy. In order for this to happen successfully, we have fostered a whole school approach to behaviour and discipline. Through the use of our agreed system we will achieve consistency; every member of our community has a clear understanding of the high expectations we have for behaviour and therefore we will create a positive environment in which all will flourish and reach their full potential.



RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOL

UNCRC stands for 'United Nations Convention on the rights of the child'.

It was created by UNICEF and has 54 articles which are all the rights a child has. It builds on the basics that a child has the right: *To survival *To develop to the fullest *To protection from harmful influences, abuse and exploitation *To participate fully in family, cultural and social life.

We decided to become a Rights Respecting School because we want Lake Farm Park Academy to be a better place for everyone. We want to teach children; not only about their rights but also help them to respect the rights of others.

From Nursery to Year 4, we teach children about their rights. Each class makes a class charter in September. This charter is agreed and signed by the children and shows how they can make sure everybody's rights are respected.

We will be sending out a leaflet soon with the UNCRC Articles. You should talk about them and how important they are.



PUNCTUALITY

Good punctuality means making sure your child is at school and ready to learn before the bell rings! This means arriving early. Try to get to school for 10 minutes early and get your child settled ready to learn.

LOST MINUTES = LOST LEARNING

5 minutes = 3 days lost

10 minutes = 6.5 days lost

15 minutes = 10 days lost

20 minutes = 13 days lost

30 minutes = 19 days lost

ATTENDANCE

Requests for term time holidays need to be put in writing. You will be aware that we cannot authorise term time holidays, therefore if you take your child out of school during term time you may be issued with a fine by the Educational Welfare Officer of Hillingdon Council. I will be calling parents in to see me if your child has poor attendance. We will also refer you to the EWO.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

At Lake Farm Park Academy all children are expected to wear school uniform every day.

Please make sure you check the school's uniform requirements on the website and ensure your child is in full school uniform. Also ensure all clothing and PE kit is labelled clearly with your child's name.

If your child is not wearing the correct uniform and school shoes, a slip will be sent home. After the third slip parents will be called in to meet the Principal.

We are also introducing the school blazer for selected Pupil Voice children. If your child has applied and been selected to be a Class Ambassador, Learning Council or School Council member then you may purchase a LFPA blazer for your child to wear to school.

White or black trainers/plimsolls
